Be Cultural

Leeuwarden may not be European Capital of Culture anymore, but there is still plenty to do culturally. Spot some beautiful Street Art! You can book a private street art tour or take a walk yourself with the help of our **Street Art Map**. Visit the former prison **Blokhuispoort** (57), which has been turned into the cultural heart of Leeuwarden with a hostel, library and which also houses many startups. Leeuwarden has a couple of truly fine museums, such as the **Fries Museum** (19) and the **Ceramics museum** (20). Don't miss out on the smaller ones like the **Historic house museum van**

Fries Museum (19) and the Ceramics museum (20). Don't miss out on the smaller ones like the Historic house museum van Eysinga (23), a beautiful house which takes you back to the 18th century or the Utrecht (24), a former insurance company built in 1904 in Art Nouveau style.

If you like classic cars or vintage fabrics, you must pay a visit to 't Andere Museum (22). And on the outskirts of Leeuwarden, you can find the Frisian Agricultural Museum (32).

Leeuwardens Hall of Fame

Leeuwarden has brought forth some world-famous individuals. Saskia van Uylenburgh was born here in 1612, she would later marry a certain painter called Rembrandt van Rijn. The graphic artist M.C. Escher was also born in Leeuwarden (20). You may have also heard of the exotic dancer / double spy Mata Hari, who was born in Leeuwarden in 1876. You can still see her house of birth (58).

From 1584 to 1747, Leeuwarden was the residence of the ancestors of the current **Dutch Royal Family**. They settled in the Stadhouderlijk Hof (59) in 1587. They were buried in the crypt of the Grote of Jacobijnerkerk (51) (Open: Sat: 13:00-16:00, Summer: Tue-Sat 11:00-16:00). **Maria Louise von Hessen Kassel** was the last Nassau Princess who lived in Leeuwarden. You can visit a mural dedicated to her and inspect her family tree (66) at the Oldehoofsterkerkhof square. You might spot some very familiar faces! The Nassau Room in her former house, the Princessehof, still shows in what kind of splendour Maria Louise and her family used to live.

Walking Tours in Leeuwarden

A walking tour through Leeuwarden is the best way to discover the city and our local guides love to share its beauty and stories. Every Saturday at 12:00 (noon) we offer two walking tours, one in **English** and one in Dutch. Saturdays at 14:00 we also offer a tour in Dutch and one in German. Our other public tours are in Dutch. Our guides will show you Leeuwarden through the eyes of a local. Expect a passionate guide, funny historical stories, beautiful street art and cute little shops and art galleries. It's the best introduction to the city! Our tours have been the best rated tours of Leeuwarden on **TripAdvisor** since 2013!

The **starting point** for our tours is the Oldehoofsterkerkhof, the square in front of the Oldehove (the leaning tower). Our guides will be waiting for you next to the entrance of the Visitor Center Leeuwarden (inside the Obe pavilion) and nearby the tiled tableau of Maria Louise.

Private Walking Tour


